

#### Two tracks

- Full-time, with presence in the country, 3 years
- Professional, completely remote with presence optional, 4-5 years

There is a mandatory participation once a year in our annual meetings with teaching sessions, PhD colloquia and interim presentations of the respective research status, etc., either on site at our Institute in Guinea-Bissau or live online.

## Formal requirements for your application

- Bachelor's and Master's degree with an equivalent total of 300 ECTS
- Curriculum Vitae
- · Your letter of motivation
- · Your first research proposal draft

#### Important aspects

- · You will get an interview within two weeks
- Decision on admissions to the program within four weeks after receipt of your application
- · Start immediately after your admission
- · You will get your individual study plan
- Workload: 180 ECTS (equivalent to three years of full-time study)

## Fees (as of October 2022)

- Enrollment fee: EUR 1,350 / USD 1,500
- Annual fees: EUR 7.750 / USD 8.500 (fulltime, 3 years)
- Annual fee of EUR 4,650 / USD 5,100 (professional, 5 years)
- Examination fee: EUR 1.750 / USD 2.000
